Thursday 7th December 2.30 p.m. 6.30 p.m. Class 3 Play

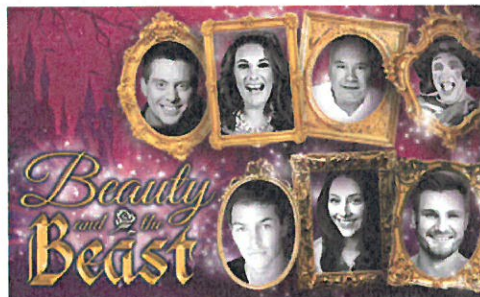
