Thursday 7th December 2.30pm 6.30pm Class 3 Play

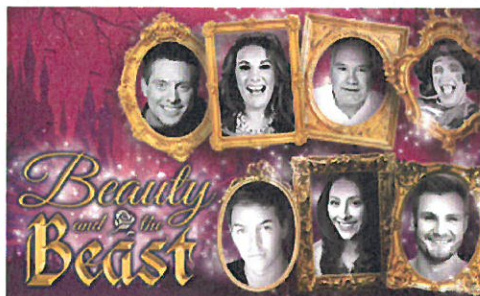
