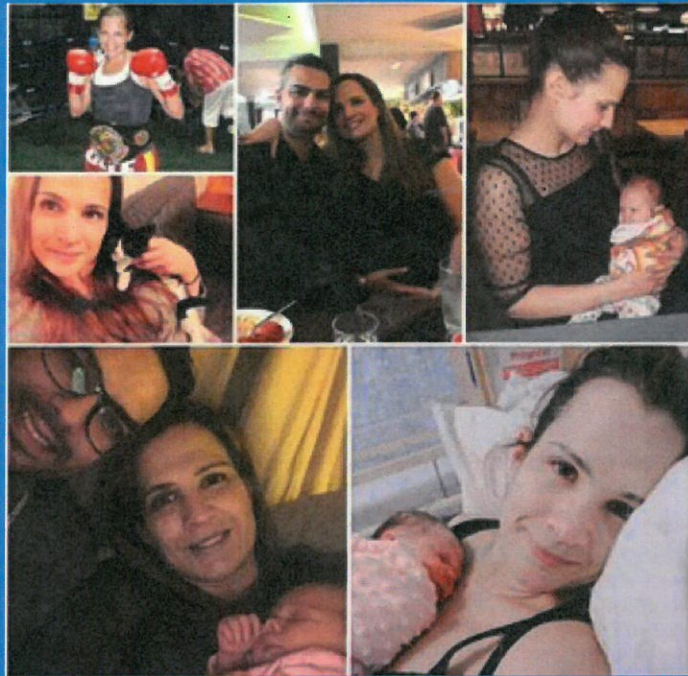
IMPORTANT FUND RAISING
