They also need to wear a badge in their house colour pinned to their t-shirts. These can be purchased through the PTA and are being sold in the playground. Alternatively, they may wear a ribbon of their house colour.

SPORTS DAY PARKING

The car park adjacent to the club house on Cricketers' Hill will be open. It can accommodate approximately 40 vehicles and once full the gate will be closed. Overflow parking will be accessible from Beeby Road as usual. Please follow the directions given by our car park officials. Please do not park on the road opposite either entrance to the cricket pitch as it causes major congestion problems for other road users and parents leaving the field.

Could I also ask parents not to drive off the cricket pitch via the Beeby Road entrance until all the children have left the area as this can cause obvious problems with children and cars trying to exit through the gate together.

The children will leave for their tea in the Village Hall after the races have finished. The PTA raffle will then be drawn at the cricket pitch. After the children have had their tea they can be collected from the playground as usual at 5 p.m. Cream teas will be available in the cricket pavilion until 5 p.m.
