When in church.....

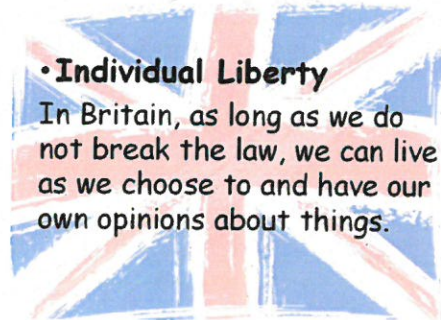
