Last Day of Term

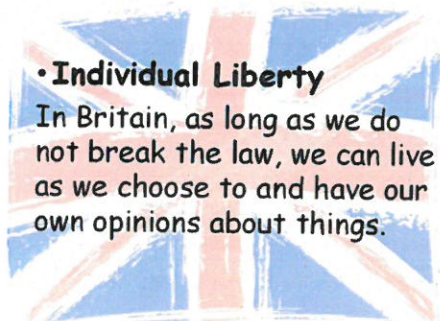
