Dear Parents, Governors and Friends,

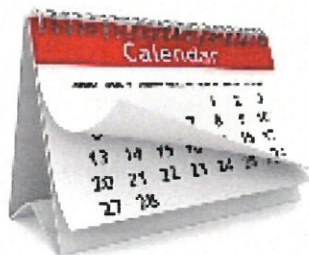
This week we have been.....

We can give respect to others and we can expect other people to show us respect.


• Tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs
