



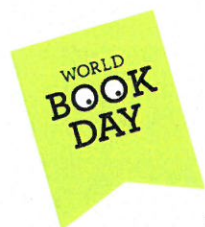

Tuesday 26th March 2019 - Class 3 and 4 production 2pm and 6pm

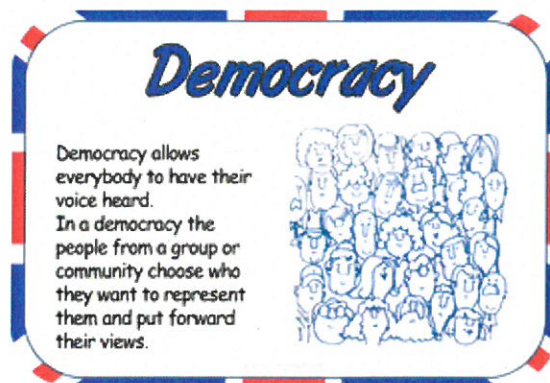
Wednesday 10th April 2019 - Easter service in church 9am
