
** Mad March Hair – Friday 23rd March

Size: approximately 12 inches square (but can be round or rectangular if you'd prefer).

Rules: Please purchase your entry slip from the PTA or the school office. (Please fill in the

slip and attach securely on the base of your work).

All entries should be brought into school by Friday, 9th March

Prizes: Judging will take place on the day. Prizes will be awarded to the most creative

entries.

Feel free to use a wide range of materials to construct your garden, such as sand, soil, pebbles, greenery, flowers, twigs etc.
