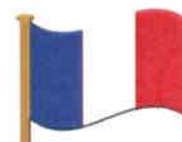
New date for your diary - We are holding our Jeans for Genes day on Friday 25 October. You can wear your Jeans to school in return for a charity donation.

School Lane


