Please write at least 8 sentences. <p>Here is an example,</p> <p>The enormous, hairy giant angrily stomped into the kitchen when he heard a noise.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please use the writing prompt sheet 'What would you do if you had a pet dragon?' Please describe your pet dragon and write a short story about what would happen if you flew away together. <p>Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: There is a PowerPoint to view on apostrophes (Document C) – it talks about both apostrophes for contractions aswell as possession.
